2012 ISI Spring Invitational
Sunday, March 25th, 2012

Pond Ice Arena would like to invite you to join us for the 2012 ISI Spring Invitational. The competition will be held on Sunday, March 25, 2012 at Pond Ice Arena, 101 John F Campbell Drive, Newark, DE 19711. The event is open to all members and all other District 4 ISI skaters, whose tests have been registered with ISI by March 10, 2012.

Skaters may not enter an event at a lower or higher level than their last test passed. Non-flash photography and videotaping during the competition is allowed for personal use only.

Eligibility:

All competitors must be current, individual members of ISI. If you are not a member, you can register at www.skateisi.org. Skaters may not enter an event at a lower or higher level than their last test passed. Members of USFS, who are also individual members of ISI, are eligible to compete in the new Open Freestyle events after passing the required Open Freestyle equivalency test listed below.

Rules:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines contained in the most recent edition of the ISI Handbook. All Coaches are responsible to make sure that their competitors are aware of the performance rules with the guidelines contained in the 2012 ISI Handbook as outlined in this new publication.

Skaters will be grouped together by age and level. The Competition Director will determine age grouping according to the enrollment in the competition.

Awards:

Individuals placing in 1st to 5th places will receive awards. Groups with 5+ skaters will follow a point system.

Music and Registration:

All skaters must register one hour prior to scheduled program event at the registration desk and turn in their music. Compact Discs will **only** be accepted. Music is to be labeled with the skater's name, team name, division, age and side to be played. No more than one program on a cd! Please bring a back-up in case the first copy does not work.

Vendors:

There will be vendors for competition photography and videography and selected sellers of skating-related items.

Awards:

Award ceremonies will be conducted every hour on the hour through the day and posted on the wall.



Judges/Coaches:

Each rink is required to ensure that qualified judges cover their teams' scheduled judging time. Judges must be a Professional member of the ISI and **MUST BE AN ISI CERTIFIED JUDGE**. All ISI Professional members who have passed any level of ISI Judge Certification exam prior to October 1st 2011, must complete and pass the judges update test. If a qualified team representative does not show up for your teams required time, 5 points will be deducted from your teams total score. At least one judge is needed per every 10 skaters from each rink. If only one judge turns in an inquiry form from your team they will be scheduled for all required team time. Credentials will be distributed on Sunday morning; only Coaches who are current professional members and are on the schedule for judging will receive a credential. A Coach without a credential will not be permitted in the competition rink area as well as the judges' hospitality room. **Coaches who elect not to judge will have the option to pay a \$50.00 fee for a coaching credential. Payment should be made to the Pond Ice Arena.**

USFS Conversions:

Members of the USFS who are individual members and registered with the ISI are eligible to compete in accordance with the ISI/USFS Joint Statement of Policy.

If a USFSA skater has passed any of the Freestyle Tests: He/She may compete in:

Pre-Preliminary, Adult Pre Bronze, Adult Bronze
Preliminary, Pre-Juvenile, Adult Silver
Juvenile, Intermediate, Adult Gold
Novice, Junior, Senior

Freestyle 3 / Bronze
Freestyle 4-5 / Silver
Freestyle 5-6 / Gold
Freestyle 7-10 / Platinum

DIRECTIONS

From locales NORTH of Delaware:

Travel I-95 South into Delaware, exit onto Route 273 West (towards Newark). Continue on Route 273 approx 3 miles (passing the FMC facility on your left). Turn left at the Marrows Road intersection (stop light controlled intersection; 84 Lumber will be on your right, Shell gas station on your left) and continue approx 2 blocks. Immediately following the Newark Animal Hospital, turn left onto John F Campbell Drive (as if you were turning into the Toyota dealership). The rink is at the end of the drive.

From locales SOUTH of Delaware:

Travel I-95 North into Delaware, exit onto Route 273 West (towards Newark). Continue as above.

From the Southern Delaware locales: Travel Route 1 North, exit onto Route 273 West.

From Lancaster/Reading:

Take Route 41 south past Avondale (2-3 miles) to Route 7 south. Go three miles and turn right onto route 72 south. Follow Route 72 south 6 miles (do not turn at Shell station, stay straight) to end. Turn left onto Cleveland Ave. Go three miles turn right at Porter Chevrolet, go under train tracks and bear left (McDonalds on right). Turn left at light, go to next light, one block) turn right at Bennigans. Go one block to next light and turn left at Toyota Dealership. The rink is behind the car dealership. Time from Lancaster 1.15 hours, time from Reading 1.5 hours.

NOTE: There is no penalty given for the quantity of swizzles, strokes or crossovers in the Pre-Alpha - Beta levels. Only the quality of these maneuvers is judged.
