Treasurer's Report

Club Membership

The club will be taking an opportunity at the Spring Splash competition to encourage RIZ skaters who are not already club members to join the club for the upcoming season. We will also be looking into soliciting Charlottesville and Fredericksburg skaters to join the club since their rinks are closing. We are also going to encourage parents to join the club this year.

Test Session

The test session for June will be held at SNP and the CVSC will be supplying the judges. The August session will be hosted by CVSC at RIZ. It is possible that the August test session may be a 2 day test session and may have judging critiques for skaters. No decision has been made at this time.

Miscellaneous

Governing Council-

Diane Brown attended the Governing Council on May 1. She states it went well with lots of new information and changes to come. A primary focus was on the need to attract and retain members.

Adults- A new adult test track for moves in the field beyond the adult gold moves has been created beginning with intermediate moves. The passing average will be 0.2 lower for adults between 25 and 49 and 0.4 lower for those 50+.

USFS is having a 75 min film made called "Rise". This will go from the 1961 plane crash thru the rise of figure skating today. This film will be released February 17, 2011.

Banquet –

This will be a non-ice event to recognize skaters with pins, etc... The banquet is scheduled for May 22. The final details are moving along. An email will be sent out to members for a reminder and to get a final head count. The club will be inviting Mike, rink manager, to come to our banquet.

Skate 4 Babies-

The club will be creating 2 ads for Skate 4 Babies, 1 a ¼ size honoring our seniors and 1 a ¼ size for the CVSC.

Spring Splash-

This year's Spring Splash will be held on May 15 at Richmond Ice Zone. The club is providing flowers to sell during the competition and providing tissues in the goody bags for the skater

participants. There will also be coupons from the café for goody bags. The club will be creating 'Welcome' posters for the other rinks to the competition.

August Basic Skills Competition-

The rink will not be hosting this year's competition. The rink has asked the club if the CVSC would like to host the competition. After some discussion, the club has decided not to host at this time. Maybe in the future.

Storage Shed-

Mike has offered the club a room in the rink for club storage versus a storage shed outside in the back parking lot. The club has accepted his offer of the room with a big 'Thank-you'.

Annual meeting- The club will be asking the Kunkas if they would be willing to host the club's annual meeting again as they had hosted the meeting last year.

Summer programs-
